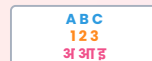

Big Letters!



At a Glance

Class Band	1st – 2nd Class
Purpose	Use the reusable practice chart as a short daily literacy and numeracy station.
Teacher Focus	Focus on one small learning target at a time.



What the Kit Provides

- Cylindrical reusable learning drum with a double-sided A4 practice chart
- Front: Numbers 0–9 and English A–Z with tracing, counting and recognition
- Back: Hindi Swar and Vyanjan with tracing and picture-word recognition
- Write-and-wipe surface for repeated practice and self-correction



Learning Objective

Build recognition, tracing, counting, early word building and independent practice habits.



Duration

10 – 15 minutes



Preparation

Place the drum within reach and select one number, letter or picture-word target.

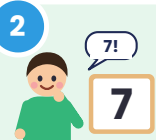
Step-by-Step Teacher Guide

Activity: Roll, Reveal and Practise



Open and unroll

Invite the child to open the drum and unroll the chart carefully.



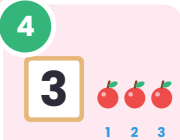
Name it first

Point to one target and ask the child to identify it before writing.



Model and trace

Model one tracing stroke, then let the child trace and rewrite.



Count objects

For numbers, connect the number to objects the child can count.



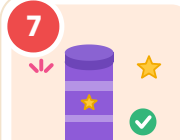
Letter and picture

For letters, ask the child to find a familiar related word or picture.



Check and improve

Ask the child to check the work, erase and improve one part.



Roll and close

Roll the chart back into the drum and close it independently.

Teacher Prompts

- Which number or letter do you see?
- Can you show the same number using objects?
- Where should your writing begin?
- Can you find a picture or word for this letter?
- What did you improve on your second attempt?

Learning Outcomes

- Fine-motor control and hand-eye coordination are strengthened.
- Children practise letter formation, stroke direction, recognition and counting.
- Picture activities support vocabulary and letter-sound mapping.
- Write-and-wipe practice builds self-correction and independence.



Quick Assessment

- Child identifies the selected number or letter correctly.
- Child follows the tracing direction with improving control.
- Child checks and corrects one part of the work.



Safety and Care

- Use the supplied child-safe marker only on the laminated chart.
- Keep the drum and chart clean and dry.
- Roll the chart gently to avoid creases.
