At a Glance

Class Band	1st – 2nd Class
Purpose	Use the activity wear before clay, colour and craft sessions as a preparation and independence routine.
Teacher Focus	Treat the wear as part of the learning routine, not only as protective clothing.

What the Kit Provides

- Durable, non-toxic cotton activity wear
- Two side tie strings, a top loop and a front pocket
- Machine washable and reusable
- Supports confident participation in hands-on activities

Learning Objective

Develop self-help, bilateral coordination, preparation and clean-up routines.

Duration

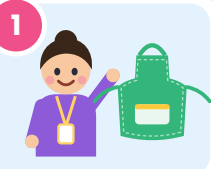

Preparation

Place the activity wear where children can reach it safely.

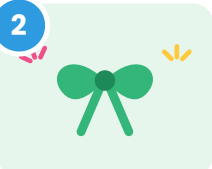
Step-by-Step Teacher Guide

Activity: Ready, Set, Create



Wear it

Show how to hold the top loop and put the wear on.



Tie the strings

Guide the child to position and tie the side strings comfortably.



Fill the pocket

Ask the child to place only the required small materials in the front pocket.



Create!

Complete the planned clay, colour or craft activity.



Remove and return

Ask the child to remove the wear and return materials to their places.



Store it

Place the wear in the cleaning or storage location.

Teacher Prompts

- What do we do before a messy activity?
- Can you tie the strings safely?
- Which materials do you need?
- Where will everything go after the activity?

Learning Outcomes

- Children develop self-help skills and bilateral coordination.
- Children follow a preparation, activity and clean-up sequence.
- Children practise organised handling and ownership of materials.

Quick Assessment

- Child puts on and removes the wear with minimal help.
- Child follows the agreed preparation and clean-up sequence.

Safety and Care

- Check that ties are secure and comfortable.
- Supervise strings, especially with younger children.
- Wash and dry the wear before storing.
