At a Glance

Class Band	1st – 2nd Class
Purpose	Use the marker to establish a write, check, erase and improve routine.
Teacher Focus	The main teaching purpose is self-correction, not simply writing.

What the Kit Provides

- Child-grip whiteboard marker with a cap-mounted eraser
- Low-odour, non-toxic, quick-drying and wipe-clean ink
- Designed for easy grip by young children
- Supports immediate write-check-erase practice and self-assessment

Learning Objective

Build confidence with practice, revision, neat presentation and self-assessment.

Duration

5 – 10 minutes

Use With

The laminated Practice Drum chart, Creative Cards or another compatible write-and-wipe surface.

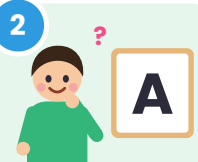
Step-by-Step Teacher Guide

Activity: Write, Check and Improve



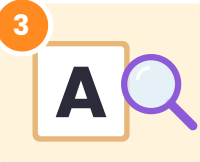
Introduce the activity

Ask the child to complete one short task.



Pause and observe

Ask the child to look at the work before correcting it.



Find improvement

Invite the child to find one part that can be improved.



Use the eraser

Use the cap eraser to remove only that part.



Rewrite

Ask the child to rewrite the corrected portion.



Celebrate

Appreciate the effort and progress, not just the final answer.

Teacher Prompts

- What would you change?
- Can you find your own mistake?
- How can you make this letter or number clearer?
- What improved after your second attempt?

Learning Outcomes

- Children experience mistakes as a normal part of learning.
- Children practise reviewing and revising their own work.
- Self-assessment and neat presentation habits are reinforced.

Quick Assessment

- Child identifies and corrects one error with minimal prompting.

Safety and Care

- Keep the cap secured when not in use.
- Use only on intended write-and-wipe surfaces.
- Store in a cool, dry place.
- Adult supervision recommended for younger children.
