At a Glance

Class Band	1st – 2nd Class
Purpose	Use the pouch as a daily organisation and responsibility routine.
Teacher Focus	Make returning materials part of the learning session.

What the Kit Provides

- Durable, tear- and water-resistant pouch with handle and zip
- Inner pocket for cards and sheets
- Keeps the complete learning set together
- Returning items develops organisation, ownership and care

Learning Objective

Develop organisation, responsibility and care for learning materials.

Duration

3 – 5 minutes

Preparation

Show children where each item belongs before the activity.

Step-by-Step Teacher Guide

Activity: Pack, Use and Return



Open and take out

Open the pouch and take out only the materials required.



Cards in the pocket

Keep cards and sheets in the inner pocket.



Quick count

After the activity, conduct a quick item count.



Return each item

Ask children to return each item to its correct place.



Zip and store

Close the zip and return the pouch to its storage location.

Teacher Prompts

- What did we take out?
- Where does this card belong?
- Is anything missing?
- How do we keep our materials ready for tomorrow?

Learning Outcomes

- Children practise organisation and ownership.
- Children develop a repeatable preparation and restoration routine.
- Correct storage supports regular use and reduces loss.

Quick Assessment

- Child returns materials to the correct place without repeated prompting.
- Child notices and reports a missing item.

Safety and Care

- Keep the pouch dry and clean.
- Do not overload the zip or place sharp objects inside.
