Scope Alignment	Write-and-wipe table-top calendar with date, day, month and time sections.
Teacher Note	Make it a five-minute morning routine.

What the Kit Provides

- Table-top calendar with stand (min. 9 × 7.5 inches)
- Date, Day, Month, Time and Parts of the Day
- Spiral leaves laminated both sides for marker use
- Rigid stand, neat binding, smooth edges

Make time concrete through a daily date, day, month and clock routine.

Set up

Stand the calendar and turn to the correct leaf.



Write today

The Calendar Helper writes date, day and month.



Say it together

"Today is...
Yesterday was...
Tomorrow will be..."



Tell the time

Draw the clock hands for the time given.



Question of the day

Write a fresh question; answer before home time.



Wipe for tomorrow

Wipe clean and choose a new helper.

Teacher Prompts

- What day was yesterday?
- Which month comes after June?
- Where does the short hand point?
- How long is it until lunch?

Expected Learning Outcomes

- Calendar sense and sequencing of days and months develop.
- Children read hours and minutes and understand duration.
- A daily routine builds planning and anticipation.

Quick Assessment

- Writes the full date correctly.
- Reads and shows time on the clock face.
- Names days and months in order.

Safety and Care

- Use only a whiteboard marker on the leaves.
- Turn leaves gently from the spiral.
- Keep it on a dry, flat surface.
