At a Glance

Class Band	3rd – 5th Class
Scope Alignment	Child-grip whiteboard marker with cap-mounted eraser, non-toxic and wipe-clean.
Teacher Note	Teach the tripod grip and the cap-on habit.

What the Kit Provides

- Minimum 100 mm whiteboard marker with cap-mounted eraser
- Low-odour, non-toxic, quick-drying ink
- Barrel shaped for a young child's grip
- Wipes clean without ghosting



Learning Objective

Build self-assessment, neat presentation and a correct writing grip.

5 – 10 minutes

Step-by-Step Teacher Guide

Simple Steps, Big Learning!

1



Hold it right

Use the tripod grip, a little above the tip.

2



Write neatly

Write the answer, sentence or working.

3



Check it

Check the answer, spelling, punctuation and columns.

4



Erase the error

Use the cap eraser to remove only the mistake.

5



Rewrite

Rewrite and mark answers you corrected yourself.

6



Cap on, every time

Push the cap on firmly; store the marker flat.

Teacher Prompts

- Is your grip relaxed?
- What will you check first?
- What did you correct yourself?
- How does your work look now?

Expected Learning Outcomes

- Mistakes become a normal part of learning.
- Children review and revise their own work.
- Self-assessment, neatness and a correct grip develop.

Quick Assessment

- Checks and erases mistakes independently.
- Holds the marker with a tripod grip.
- Closes the cap after every use.

Safety and Care

- Replace the cap immediately after use.
- Use only on write-and-wipe surfaces.
- Do not press hard or put it in the mouth.
